Dr. Smith served as the head of the League of Christian Schools for nearly ten years. For nearly a decade, Dr. Smith served as the dedicated head of the League of Christian Schools, a role that he approached with passion and a deep sense of purpose. Under his guidance, the League flourished, nurturing a generation of students who were not only academically adept but also grounded in strong Christian values. Dr. Smith's commitment to education extended beyond the classroom. He believed in the power of knowledge to transform lives and communities. His leadership was marked by inclusivity and a genuine desire to provide quality education to all, regardless of background or circumstance.

Dr. Smith has led more school accreditations than can be counted. His valuable contributions to Christian education can be found in the organizational fabric in hundreds of schools he guided in long term improvement through the accreditation process. He was also a consummate mentor to pastors and school leaders all over world. Additionally, Dr. Smith



has impacted many teachers as a professor and coordinator of the masters program at Southeastern University. He taught in both the Masters and Doctoral programs. His dedication to education and faith will continue to inspire future generations to lead lives of purpose and compassion.

The Charles K. Smith Scholarship program supports the mission of the League of Christian Schools to empower students for passionate Christian service by:


- Promote the League of Christian Schools by awarding scholarships to students of LCS schools.

Scholarship Selection

The scholarship recipients are determined by a blind vote of the Board of Directors in the regularly scheduled meeting following the scholarship deadline. The vote will be collected as a blind vote to eliminate influence or duress. Each board member will select the individuals they feel best meet the criteria for the scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded to the two applicants with the highest number of votes. If a tie results, a tie-breaking vote will be cast for just the applicants that tied. Letters of Award Notification, along with Letters of Regret, will be mailed via regular mail within 30 days of the final determination of the Board of Directors. If a student rejects the scholarship offer prior to August 1 of their original freshman year, the scholarship will be awarded to the applicant with the next highest votes. If a tie exists between the remaining applicants, the tie breaking rule above will be observed. If the applicant rejects the offer after August 1, or does not attend the university, no further action will be taken, and the scholarship will not be awarded. If a student withdraws from college during the first two years, they will lose the scholarship. The decision of the Board of Directors is final in all cases.

Instructions for Scholarship Applicants

Essays

Please prepare the following document with your name and the name of your school in the upper right-hand corner. In your paper please include:

- A brief autobiography, no longer than one and one-half pages (excluding translation for international students), describing:
 - o Academic strengths and challenges
 - o Acceptance of Christ
 - Work experience
 - o Christian service activities
- A detailed statement of intent, no longer than two pages, describing:
 - Your proposed field of study and future career plans, including an explanation of how these plans will advance the cause of Christ.
 - o How you determined your choice of college and how they support your goals for Christian service.

Recommendation Forms

Applicants should complete Section I and your principal and two academic instructors or appropriate advisors complete Section II of the Recommendation Forms, respectively, of this application. You should inform principals, educators, or advisors completing these recommendations that it is for the purpose of the Charles K. Smith Scholarship program.

Transcripts

Provide original transcripts covering high school credits through the last semester of the Junior year, or 1st semester of the senior year.
